Accident Prevention and Safety Procedures

Through its comprehensive safety program, the district will attempt to prevent accidents by providing a safe working and learning environment. Safety procedures and accident prevention instruction will be provided to students and staff. Other precautions will be taken in order to minimize accidents and potentially harmful situations.

Further, the district will use standard safety precautions in the application of any pesticide or other potentially harmful substance on school premises. Only approved products will be used in district applications. Those products which can be applied without special licensing or training are preferred. Employees will be instructed regarding the correct and safe application of any potentially hazardous or harmful substance. The Material Safety Data Sheet for any product used for such purposes will be available for review by employees or members of the public.
