Handling Lost, Stolen and Misused Meal Tickets**

The district participate in the National School Lunch Program (NSLP), School Breakfast, Commodity, and Special Milk Programs. As a participant in these programs the district is obligated to establish specific policies concerning lost or missing meal money.

When a student has no money for a meal the district will make a special meal arrangement (charge). The student shall be allowed a maximum of three meal charges each year. Students and parents will be notified after the second charge that after a third such charge the student will be expected to bring a meal or pay the full meal price. If that student has used more than three unpaid meal charges, the student may be offered a substitute lunch.

Students with disabilities, pre-primary, and primary students who may be unable to take full responsibility for meal money shall be exempt from the three meal charge limit.

Parents and students will be provided notice of this policy each fall in a school newsletter or in the Student Responsibilities and Rights Handbook.
