Selection of Consultants

The Board may at its discretion employ a licensed consultant to design the plans and aid in supervision of proposed renovation of building mechanical systems, district owned land, program renovation, staff training or other work occasionally needed by the district.

In selecting a consultant, the following criteria shall include, but not be limited to:

1. Experience in school settings;
2. Evidence of relevant experience in American with Disabilities Act situations, such as for persons with disabilities;
3. Creative ability;
4. Technical knowledge to control the system so the best results are obtained for the smallest amount of money;
5. Executive and business ability to oversee the proper performance of sub contracts;
6. Proven ability and temperament to work cooperatively with others;
7. Willingness to consult with district staff on educational specifications;

The consultant will be selected by the district on the basis of the above criteria and will be employed under special services agreement.
