Temporary District Facilities

The Board's goal is to have sufficient permanent facilities to meet the needs of school enrollment and the school program. Rented facilities, movable units and other emergency school housing may be necessary for short-term public school purposes.

If circumstances require immediate space not available in public school buildings, facilities will be leased or movable structures will be used as a temporary measure.

The Board encourages the involvement of staff, parents and the community in the decision making process whenever possible. The superintendent will give due consideration to all such input prior to using any temporary facilities.

Any such facility must conform to all appropriate federal, state, local building, and land use codes as well as health and fire laws, environmental standards and provisions for accessibility and usability as required by the Americans with Disabilities Act.
