District Athletic Eligibility

Purpose

This policy sets forth the conditions by which home school and private school students may participate in district sponsored extracurricular activities.

Home School Students

Home school students will be considered eligible for participation in the district extracurricular activities if they meet the following criteria:

1. The student is in compliance with all the rules governing home schooling and can provide acceptable documentation of compliance to the district;
2. The student can meet the district's eligibility requirements with the exception of attendance;
3. The student can achieve the minimum achievement test score required of home-schooled students. Students may participate while awaiting test results;
4. The student must fulfill the same responsibilities, standards of behavior and performance as other students participating in the activity. The student must also comply with all public school requirements during the time of participation;
5. The student must reside in the attendance boundaries of the school for which the student participates.

Private School Students

Private school students will be considered eligible for participation in the district extracurricular activities if the following criteria are met:

1. The private school for which they attend is recognized by the Oregon School Activities Association and is an OSAA member.
2. The sport or activity for which they are asking for participation in must not be offered in the private school they attend.
3. The student must reside in the attendance boundaries of the school at which they are requesting participation.

4. The student must fulfill the same responsibilities, standards of behavior and performance as other students participating in the activity.
5. The student must also comply with all public school requirements during the time of participation.
6. The student must meet the district's eligibility requirements with the exception of attendance.
7. Permission must be granted by both the private and public high school principals.
