**Intradistrict Transfer Students**

With the superintendent's approval, the district may grant the request of a resident student to attend another in district school, provided the receiving school agrees to that request. Building capacity may be used as a determining factor in transfer decisions. District transportation will not be provided to these students and will be responsibility of the parent and/or guardian.

Students who attend a district school identified as persistently dangerous, or who are victims of a violent criminal offense occurring in or on the grounds of the school the student attends, may transfer to a safe public school in the district. The district will provide transportation for these students.

The superintendent will develop administrative regulations, as necessary, for implementation of this policy.
