Student Eligibility for CoCurricular Activities**

It is the intention of the district to provide the best educational experiences possible for students. It is the belief that a cocurricular activities program augments and strengthens what is learned in the academic program. The academic program is the primary purpose of the district and shall in no way be impeded or hampered by the cocurricular program.

Students (in grades 6-12) are expected to pass all classes or maintain a 2.0 GP A, with no more than one failing grade, and maintain good citizenship in order to participate in cocurricular activities.

The superintendent will develop administrative rules and procedures to implement this policy. Furthermore, the policy, rules and procedures will be printed in the student handbook and cocurricular handbook that is distributed to students annually.
