

Dress and Grooming

Your dress and grooming are your responsibility and the responsibility of your parents/guardians. However, the following guidelines will apply during the school day when you are in attendance at district schools (“school day” is defined as from the beginning of the first class until the end of the last class of the day):

1. Your dress and grooming will be clean and in keeping with the health, sanitation and safety practices of the State of Oregon;
2. Students may be directed to change dress and grooming if it interferes with the learning process or school climate, is unclean or threatens the health and safety of the student or others;
3. Students will wear clothing that covers their midriff and does not show cleavage;
4. No tube, strapless or backless tops are allowed and all underclothing needs to be covered;
5. Shorts and skirts need to be mid-thigh length or longer when standing;
6. No bare feet are allowed, appropriate footwear needs to be worn at all times (usually shoes are required, stocking feet are appropriate for some activities as directed by the adult supervisor);
7. Displays on clothing, including jewelry or wording which are sexually suggestive, drug related, vulgar, insulting, or which ridicule a particular person or group, or which promotes membership in a gang, secret society, or socially inappropriate group are prohibited;
8. Hats, bandanas, headbands and sunglasses are not to be worn in the building.

If you participate in activities/athletics you will be expected to follow the guidelines set forth by the adult supervisor, coach or advisor.

Discipline may be assigned for violation of these guidelines.
