

## **Board Member Removal from Office**

The Board shall declare the office of a Board member vacant if it finds any of the following:

1. The death or resignation of an incumbent;
2. When an incumbent is removed or recalled from office or the election of the incumbent is declared void by the judgment of a court;
3. When an incumbent ceases to be a resident of the district from which nominated or elected;
4. When an incumbent has not discharged the duties of office for three consecutive regular monthly meetings unless prevented by sickness or other unavoidable cause or unless granted an excuse by the Board chair.

Vacancies will be filled through appointment by the Board unless a majority of the positions are vacant at the same time. In that case, vacancies will be filled by the county board of commissioners.
