

Board Member Removal from Office

The Board shall declare the office of a Board member vacant if it finds any of the following:

1. The death or resignation of an incumbent;
2. When an incumbent is removed or recalled from office or the election of the incumbent is declared void by the judgment of a court;
3. When an incumbent ceases to be a resident of the district from which nominated or elected;
4. When the incumbent has ceased to discharge the duties of office for two consecutive months unless prevented therefrom by sickness or other unavoidable cause or unless excused by the chairperson of the board.

If the offices of a majority of the board members are vacant at the same time, the governing body of the principal county shall appoint persons to fill the vacancies from any of the electors of the district if the positions are filled by both nomination and election at-large, and otherwise from any of the electors of the zone from which the vacancy occurs.
