

Nontraditional Credit

The Nontraditional credits include Advanced Placement Program (AP), College Level Examination Program (CLEP) and credit for prior learning (such as military or government training).

Nontraditional credit may be granted under the following conditions:

1. AP and CLEP exams and scores must meet the department level criteria;
2. A student must be enrolled and have earned credit at TVCC before credit is awarded;
3. A maximum of 12 credits may be earned in a specific subject area;
4. A maximum of 24 credits may be applied toward a TVCC certificate;
5. A maximum of 45 credits may be applied toward a TVCC degree;
6. Nontraditional credit is not graded and will not affect the grade point average (GPA).
