General Admissions

The College may admit the following individuals:

1. Graduates from accredited high schools;
2. Individuals who have earned the GED Certificate of Equivalency or an Adult High School Diploma; or
3. Non-high school graduates who are at least 18 years of age and whose high school class has graduated.

The College may admit the following individuals as special students:

1. Individuals of at least 16 years of age, who are not required to attend high school and who furnish a written release from compulsory school attendance;
2. Students currently attending high school who present written permission from their high school officials.

Special admission standards may be imposed for specific instructional programs.

Placement Testing

All new degree seeking students will be required to take placement tests prior to registration. These placement tests determine course level placement and in no way prevent admission to the College.

Any non-degree seeking student intending to enroll in an English or math course should first take the respective placement tests to determine entry level placement.

Enrollment in specific developmental course work will be recommended if placement test results indicate that the student would benefit by doing so.
