

Staff Dress and Grooming

Staff must minimally meet the requirements for students as outlined in the student handbook with respect to dress and grooming.

Student Contact Days

1. Men must wear slacks with a collared shirt (Henley's are acceptable);
2. Women must wear dress slacks/pant suits/dresses. Dresses cannot be any shorter than three inches above the knee;
3. No denim (jeans) except on Fridays when wearing a school shirt;
4. No shorts/skorts;
5. No flip flop shoes (i.e., thongs);
6. No T-shirts (i.e., logos);
7. Physical education teachers need to follow these guidelines when teaching in a classroom or in the building for a period of time. If they are switching back and forth, they may wear nice sweat pants;
8. When attending a field trip with students, the staff member should dress according to the nature of the trip;
9. Teachers are encouraged to participate in student dress up spirit days.

Nonstudent Contact Days

Staff should dress according to the plans of the day.

Special Events

These include open houses, conferences, award assemblies and graduation.

1. Men should be in slacks, collared shirt and tie;
2. Women should be in dresses or pant suits.
