Relations with Law Enforcement Agencies

When a law officer wishes to confer with or question a student at the school, the principal or his/her designee shall be present at the meeting and the student's parents shall be notified of the meeting, preferably in advance.

A student may be removed from school by a law officer with a court order or an authorized representative of the Oregon Department of Human Services, Community Human Services.

Outside agencies may deliver subpoenas and warrants to students in the presence of an administrator.

It is the intent of the Board to maintain a cooperative relationship with law enforcement agencies. Law officers' presence and participation in school programs are encouraged to promote a positive attitude by students toward police.

Whenever a student is suspected of involvement in a crime, the school administrator will attempt to notify his/her parents prior to any police action at school. Exception to this would occur only when such notification is contrary to established legal procedures or when immediate police action is required to ensure student or other persons' welfare.
