Student Government

The Board recognizes and approves student council bodies as part of the educational process. These must be established in accordance with the students' level of maturity.

Student council bodies shall be "of students, by students and for students." Student councils shall represent all students in organizing student activities and communicating with the school administrator.

The building principal shall select an advisor to work with the student council body. The advisor will be responsible for arranging local, state, regional and/or national level training for student council members. The Board directs the superintendent to ensure such training occurs.

All district classes and organizations have their own officers and a certain amount of self-rule. The Associated Student Council consists of a president, vice president, secretary, treasurer and representatives from the classes, clubs and organizations in the school. Council matters of importance are settled by a vote of the entire student body.

Any legislation passed by the council is subject to review by the administration. Every effort is made to allow students to develop responsibility and leadership.

All authority in the school must rest on the administration and ultimately on the Board, but students are encouraged to develop responsibility and prove themselves capable of making and enforcing most of their own rules, such as conduct in the halls, lunch room and at social affairs.
