

Student Dress and Grooming**

The Board recognizes its responsibilities to the community in providing a proper educational environment for students. We realize, with the community, the joint obligation and effort to develop attitudes and character traits commensurate with community standards. We are also charged with the safety of students and the creation of a satisfactory and appealing environment free of elements that focus away from acceptable school situations.

Giving consideration to personal values and economic status of families, students will be required to be clean and neat and of an appearance that we believe to be acceptable to community standards.

Student appearance should be of a nature that:

1. Avoids distractions;
2. Allows for full participation in school activities;
3. Will not endanger the student's personal health and/or safety or of other students;
4. Is consistent with community-school standards;
5. Promotes wholesome attitudes and sound character traits.

Students who represent the school in a voluntary activity may be required to conform to dress and grooming standards and may be denied the opportunity to participate if those standards are not met.
