## Non-Student Loitering

To help protect student and school property and to prevent disruptive activity, district officials must know if any persons who are not members of the staff or student body are inside the building or on the grounds.

Visitors are welcome in district buildings so long as their presence is not disruptive and district officials are aware of the visit.

Visitors in the building during a normal school day are expected to come first to the main office and arrange for the conduct of their business.

No individual may loiter in or near a school building or grounds. Loitering means not having any reason or relationship involving custody of or responsibility for a student, or upon inquiry, not having a specific, legitimate reason for being there.
