## Visitors to the Schools

To help protect student and school property, the individuals within the school, and to prevent disruptive activity, school officials must know if any persons who are not members of the staff or student body are inside the building or on the grounds.

No individual may loiter in or near a school building or grounds. Loitering means not having any reason or relationship involving custody of, or responsibility for, a student, or, upon inquiry, not having a specific, legitimate reason for being in the school building or on the grounds.

No student or other individual shall loiter in or near a school building or grounds during the period when school is not normally in session nor shall a person enter in or loiter about the building or grounds during any period in which the building is open for a specific function in which that individual is not involved.

Visitors in the school building or on the school grounds during the normal school day shall first come to the office to arrange to conduct their business. At the principal's discretion, visitors may be required to have a "visitor's permit."

Any persons on school property who have not registered with the school office are on school property illegally and will be asked to identify themselves properly or to leave the school grounds. If such visitors refuse to comply or create any disturbance, the principal has the authority to issue a letter of no trespass and/or refer to law enforcement officials.
