Accident Prevention and Safety Procedures

Through its comprehensive safety program, the ESD will attempt to prevent accidents by assuring a safe working environment. Warning systems such as smoke detectors will be installed; accident prevention instruction will be given to staff; safety procedures will be taught; and other precautions will be taken in order to attempt to eliminate accidents and potentially harmful situations.

Further, the ESD will use all appropriate precautions when the application of any pesticide or other potentially harmful substance is used on the ESD grounds. Only those products readily available and approved for such use will be used. Those products which can be applied without special licensing or training are most appropriate. Appropriate employees will be instructed regarding the correct and safe application of any potentially hazardous or harmful substance. The Material Safety Data Sheet for any product used for such purposes will be available for employees or members of the public.
