

Title I Parental Involvement

1. The Parent Involvement Policy shall be a working document, and may be rewritten yearly as parents review it and consult with school staff.
2. Said policy shall be sent home each fall to every participating parent and a description of the Title I program.
3. Title I teachers will be available to answer questions at each school's fall open house.
4. Title I teachers will explain the title 1 program, review parent policy, and discuss ways parents can work together to provide a successful Title 1 program for each child at the first parent-teacher conference.
5. Parents will receive written progress reports every 4.5 weeks and will conference with classroom and Title I teachers at parent-teacher conferences.
6. The Title 1 coordinator and Title 1 teachers will be available by telephone as needed.
7. Parents are welcome to observe their child during Title 1 instruction.
8. Title I Planning Committees, including parents of participating students, will meet on a regular basis. Committees may be school-wide, or project based. These committees or any representative parents will consult on the design and implementation of this program.
9. Parents will be given an opportunity to give input, evaluate the programs, and evaluate level of parental involvement through a parent survey to be sent out each May.
10. Parents will be provided information during the year about activities they can do with their children.
11. As a matter of public record, a description of the Title I program is available each March in the School Board report packet.
12. Parents will be invited to a meeting to hear about Title I in their school, their right to be involved, and the parents' role on their school's Title 1 planning committee.
