Alternative Education Programs (In-District)

Willamina Options Alternative Program has been established and approved by the district to meet the individual needs of students whose needs are not met by the regular school program. In this program, students work individually to complete course work.

Students that are not being successful in their placement of regular high school may be considered for alternative/online school. Teachers, administrators and/or parents may request that a student consider alternative placement when the student is not being successful in a traditional setting. The final determination for placement will be made by the building administrator. Students that are placed in an alternative setting will be earning regular high school credit, but will only be able to receive a standard diploma.

The district may deny alternative school admission to a student who is expelled from another school district and who subsequently becomes a resident of the district or who applies for admission to the district as a nonresident student. The district shall deny alternative school admission to a student who is expelled from another school district for an offense that constitutes a violation of applicable state or federal weapons law, and who subsequently becomes a resident of the district or who applies for admission to the district as a nonresident student.

Online/Credit Recovery Options

Students that are deficient in their credits toward their diploma may sign up for a credit recovery period and take the deficient course(s) online. There will be an established fee for this service per course. Students may not elect to take a core class that they have not previously taken.

Students that are failing a current scheduled course may not elect to drop the course due to failing status unless it is requested by the teacher/administrator. Students will still receive the failing grade on their report cards, progress reports and transcript. Therefore, students will be ineligible for all extracurricular activities (e.g., sports, dances, field trips, etc.) until the end of that semester.

Students can only sign up to take a course they have failed if they have taken that course two times without passing. Exception to this would be for senior students.

Students who participate in the alternative education options listed above are ineligible to attend school sponsored extracurricular and cocurricular activities.
