The superintendent shall develop, supervise and regularly report on the program designed to accomplish this intent.

The superintendent shall consider the emotional, physical, educational and other needs as appropriate to establishing a counseling service that will be available to every student on a timely basis.

The district staff will be involved in the development of the design, as appropriate, and shall share in the appraisal of the manner in which it functions.

Within the framework of the counseling and guidance goals, specific student and curricular objectives will be developed.
