Student Conduct**

It is the policy of the Board to provide for a Student Conduct Code and its dissemination and to provide for “due process” in the management of students as governed by these rules while attending school-sponsored activities or on district properties.

The superintendent is assigned the responsibility for providing the regulations necessary to ensure compliance with the Student Conduct Code and to ensure that the rights of all students are protected and will regularly report to the Board on these matters. District employees have the responsibility for the implementation of this policy.

Students shall comply with the written rules and regulations of the Board and staff, pursue the prescribed course of study, submit to the lawful authority of teachers and school officials, and conduct themselves in an orderly fashion.

A student code of conduct, developed under the leadership of the district administration, and in cooperation with staff, will be made available and distributed to parents and students outlining student conduct expectations and possible disciplinary actions, including consequences for disorderly conduct, as required by the No Child Left Behind Act of 2001 (NCLBA). In addition, each school may publish a student/parent handbook detailing additional rules specific to that school.
