## Student Athlete Drug Testing \*\*

### Definitions:

**Drug:** Any substance considered illegal by Oregon Statute or which is controlled by the Food and Drug Administration.

**Student Athlete:** Any student participating in interscholastic athletic programs sponsored by the district.

**Sport Season:** Fall, Winter, and Spring season begin on the first day of practice allowed by the Oregon School Activity Association and ends the day prior to the beginning date of practice of the next season.

The district is conducting a random mandatory drug testing program inclusive of all student athletes. The purpose of this testing is threefold:

1. To provide for the health and safety of all student athletes;
2. To undermine the effects of peer pressure by providing a legitimate reason for student athletes to refuse to use illegal drugs; and
3. To encourage student athletes who use drugs to participate in drug treatment programs.
