Health Services

The district will maintain a prevention oriented health services program for all students which provides:

1. Emergency health care space that is adequately equipped for providing first aid and which isolates the sick or injured child from the general student body;
2. Communicable disease control as provided in Oregon Revised Statutes;
3. Health records and health record information;
4. Adaptation of services for students with special health needs;
5. Coordination with the health education program;
6. Vision and auditory screening; and
7. Coordination with local public health services agencies.

School nurses which may be employed from time to time by the district shall be licensed to practice as registered nurses.

At least one staff member for each 60 students in each school building shall hold a current, recognized first aid card. No school building shall have less than one staff member who holds a current, recognized first aid card.
