**School Board Legal Status**

The Oregon State Constitution requires the Legislature to provide by statute a uniform and general system of common schools. The Legislature enacts laws to delegate the immediate control of the schools to locally elected school board directors. This is the Yamhill-Carlton District School Board.

State and federal statutes, court decisions and State Board of Education rules and regulations outline the general powers, duties, and responsibilities of the Board.' This includes but is not limited to the transacting of all business within the jurisdiction of the District, controlling/regulating the school, and educating the children residing in the District. The Board must carry out those duties that are mandated and it has the authority to exercise judgment and discretion in those areas where laws/rules are permissive.
