

Fund-Raising and Solicitation

1. A fund drive is the solicitation of contributions or the sale of any product or service. A fund drive may include a number of activities.
2. The organized participation of the school in traditional activities such as the Red Cross Blood Drive, food drives by the Lions Club or firemen shall be permitted. Other projects not covered by this policy must be approved by the principal.
3. Parent Club fundraising activities within the school or community when coordinated with the building principal will be permitted.
4. Other classes, clubs, teams, organizations or groups working to raise funds for school-related activities/projects must follow procedures outline in Board Policy number 5800 and A5800.
5. The various schools will coordinate fundraising activities so that the communities are not being approached by several groups at the same time.
