

Transportation Guidelines

1. District transportation vehicles will not travel any road or highway for any purpose unless the road or highway is state owned, county owned or is in some manner deeded to the public.
2. In cases where the road is not county or state owned but is otherwise publicly owned, district vehicles will travel the road only if:
 - a. Transportation service is requested by a majority of the residents living along the road;
 - b. The Board approves such transportation service in a regular Board meeting.
3. The Board will approve such transportation services only if the following requirements are satisfied:
 - a. The road is properly maintained. The definition of proper maintenance shall be the prerogative of the Board or their appointed representative;
 - b. The road is constructed to allow safe two-way passage. The definition of “safe passage” shall also be the Board’s prerogative;
 - c. Adequate turn-arounds are provided to all end points. “Adequate turn-around” shall be determined by the Board.
4. The superintendent may, at any time, suspend transportation services if it is concluded that the above requirements are not being satisfied.
5. The Board shall maintain the right to terminate transportation at any time on any road not state or county owned whether the termination is due to the fact that the above requirements are not being satisfied or due to any other set of factors which the Board determines is sufficient cause for termination.
