## Grading System

While grades are important and necessary in measuring achievement, the emphasis is on learning. Grading procedures are left up to the individual teacher's judgment, therefore, the following are only broadly defined guidelines:

<b>Grade</b>	<b>Definition</b>
A	Indicates work of excellent quality. It also means an accomplishment of at least 90 percent of the course objectives.
B	Indicates work of above-average quality. It also means an accomplishment of at least 80 percent of the course objectives.
C	Indicates work of average quality. It also means an accomplishment of at least 70 percent of the course objectives.
D	Indicates work of below-average quality. It also means accomplishment of at least 60 percent of the course objectives.
F	Indicates work of low quality. It also indicates an accomplishment of less than 60 percent of the course objectives.
I	Incomplete. Indicates that the requirements of the course have not been completed. Incompletes may be removed at any time during the school year. Incomplete automatically become an F at the end of the school year if they have not been removed during the school year.
NC	No credit due to excessive absences.
