Student Progress Reports to Parents**

Report cards will be issued following the close of each nine-week period. The grades that appear on the permanent record card are the first and second semester grades.

It is the philosophy of the district to maintain effective communication with parents. Toward this end, the schools may schedule open houses, conferences, student-parent meetings, written and verbal communications, weekly grade sheets, etc. Communication is encouraged to be informative - both positive and/or negative in nature. The intent is to keep parents informed so the school and home can work cooperatively to help a student.

Specifically, the schools will inform parents in writing whenever a student is doing failing work. A deficiency notice mailing is done approximately four weeks into each nine-week grading session. This does not exclude a teacher from communicating at other times during the nine weeks, or from sending other communications during the grading period.

No grade less than a "D" will be given to a student unless a written communication has taken place. If failing is dependent upon a final nine-week assignment (test, papers, etc.), the parents will be notified of the importance of that final assignment.

If extenuating circumstances exist that make communication with the parent impossible, the principal shall be notified prior to administering the grade.

This policy is designated to ensure maximum communication. Only through communication can the school, parents and student work to maximize learning.

In an effort to promote effective communications for individuals with disabilities, the school will provide progress reports in an alternative format upon request and with appropriate advance notice.

Primary consideration will be given to the requests of a person with a disability in the selection of appropriate auxiliary aids and services.
