## Student Withdrawal from School

The Board believes that a high school diploma signifies a minimum preparation for life. Consequently, students who withdraw from school may have less opportunity for success. Therefore, the Board strongly urges every teacher, guidance counselor, principal, parent and citizen to exert influence to keep all students in school and working towards a diploma.

The staff should recognize at risk students and do everything possible to provide guidance that leads to graduation.

The regular school program will be modified to accommodate individual student's needs and aspirations. Close contact with parents is essential and conferences with parents may be necessary.

Students are encouraged to notify the principal before withdrawing from school.

If a student does withdraw, assurance should be given that he/she may return to school at a later date with a minimum of red tape and discomfort.

The school administrators and counselors should actively endeavor to maintain contact with students who have withdrawn and to encourage the students to reevaluate their decisions.

It is the responsibility of the schools to identify potential dropouts and to use all resources available to encourage such students to remain in school. Failing this, the schools should attempt to guide former students into an alternative plan of education.
