Student Dress and Grooming**

Responsibility for dress and grooming rests primarily with students and their parents. However, the district expects student dress and grooming to meet standards which ensure that the following conditions do not exist:

1. Disruption or interference with the classroom learning environment;
2. Threat to the health and/or safety of the student concerned or other students.

Dress and grooming shall be clean, tasteful and consistent with health, sanitary and safety practices.

To assist the district and students in the health and wellness program curriculum, students will not be allowed to have clothing or jewelry with any connotation advertising for alcohol, sexuality or drugs.

Students will remove hats upon entering the classroom “as required by individual classroom teachers.”

When a student is participating in special activities, dress and grooming shall not disrupt the performance or constitute a health or safety hazard to the individual or other students.

Students who do not meet these minimum standards will be sent home immediately. Reoccurring problems with the same students will be dealt with in accordance to normal discipline procedures.
