Public Conduct on District Property

No person on district property or at district-sponsored function will:

1. Injure or threaten to injure another;
2. Damage the property of another or of the district;
3. Violate any provision of the law;
4. Violate parking regulations;
5. Drive a vehicle in an unsafe manner;
6. Impede, delay or otherwise interfere with the orderly conduct of the district's educational program or any other activity taking place on district property which has been authorized by the Board, superintendent, principal or other authorized staff member;
7. Enter upon any portion of district premises at any time for purposes other than those which are lawful and/or authorized by district officials;
8. Possess, bring an unauthorized loaded or unloaded firearm or any other instrument used as a dangerous or deadly weapon as defined in law and Board policy JFCJ - Weapons in the Schools;
9. Consume, possess, sell, give or deliver unlawful drugs including drug paraphernalia and alcoholic beverages;
10. Willfully violate other district rules and regulations designed to maintain public order on school property;
11. Initiate or circulate a report, one knows to be false, concerning an alleged hazardous substance, impending fire, explosion, catastrophe or other emergency that will take place in or upon a school.

Violators shall be dealt with as follows:

1. Students shall be subject to discipline up to and including expulsion;
2. Staff members will be subject to discipline up to and including dismissal;
3. Any other person on district property may be requested by the appropriate administrator to register at the proper office stating name, address and purpose or business on district property. Any such

person having no legitimate purpose or business on district property, violating or threatening to violate the above rules relating to the maintenance of public order shall be directed to leave the premises. Law enforcement may be contacted;

4. Parents or patrons who engage in harassing, intimidating or other behaviors including physical altercations may be excluded from school events for a period of time not to exceed one calendar year from the event. Each case will be reviewed on its own merits.

The superintendent, assisted by designated staff, will be responsible for enforcement of this policy.

In any case where violations of this policy and implementing rules and regulations do not cease after an administrative request and in other cases of willful violation of such directives, the superintendent or designee may request law enforcement officials and/or the courts for necessary assistance.
